

DYSA/ TCYSA Summer League 2010

Rules Governing Red Card and Yellow Card Violations

The DYSA/ TCYSA Summer Recreational League is bound by the laws of WSYSA, USSF and US Youth Soccer. Penalties imposed for red card violations and yellow card violations are mandated by the governing bodies of youth soccer.

RED CARD Violations:

Any person (player, coach, spectator) who receives a Red Card violation (Send Off), or is sent off by a game official without being shown a card, must immediately leave the field of play. Adults must leave the area. Any youth player that is sent off should leave the area only if accompanied by a parent or guardian. No youth player should be left unattended. In addition to being sent off for the match in which you receive a red card violation, you are also suspended for your next match. You may not watch the game or be in the vicinity of the field where the game is being played.

YELLOW CARD Violations:

Any person who receives two cautions in the same game receives an automatic Red Card send off and must leave the field of play. Adults must leave the area. Any youth player that is sent off should leave the area only if accompanied by a parent or guardian. No youth player should be left unattended. In addition to being sent off for the match in which you receive a red card violation, you are also suspended for your next match. You may not watch the game or be in the vicinity of the field where the game is being played. Any person who accumulates 3 Yellow Cards (cautions) over the course of the entire season will be suspended for one game after the match in which the third caution was received.

DYSA and TCYSA reserve the right to conduct a Disciplinary Hearing for any person who receives a send off or caution. You will be notified if a hearing is required in addition to receiving the suspensions noted above.
